- Back gate (Jan van Avenesstraat): Group 2,4 and 5




School Pick Up

Covid-19



Please note the following important information to keep the school community safe and ensure we can continue to provide face to face lessons!

If you have been in a high risk country, with or without a variant of concern, you are required to quarantine for ten days from the date of your arrival back in the Netherlands. You can check for further information in English and the list of these countries [here](#).

*You can have a Covid test on day 5 to be released from quarantine if the test comes back with a negative result.
