



Standard Terms and Conditions

School year 2026-2027

Please take the time to read all clauses in this document, and ensure that you fully understand them as it is a legally enforceable contract between you and the Harbour International School.

Entry to the school

Parents must meet the criteria for entry to the Harbour International School as a state subsidised Dutch International School. For students with any type of educational or behavioural difficulty, parents will need to provide complete documentation of their child's academic history, psychological/educational evaluations, and details of extra academic/specialist support they have had or are currently receiving. Parents must also grant permission for the school to contact previous schools or professionals involved with the child in order to provide details relevant to the child's education and well-being. Once the application information is complete, the school will evaluate the application and decide if the school can accommodate the needs of the student.

Failure to disclose information to the school relating to a child's existing learning or behavioural difficulties may jeopardise your child's placement.

If, after a period of no less than six weeks in school, we feel we cannot meet the academic, social-emotional or physical needs of your child, we reserve the right to recommend a transfer to an establishment that we believe can better accommodate these needs, which may be in the Dutch system.

School fees structure

- 1. Application fee:** For all new admissions, a non-refundable fee of **€300** is payable per student before admission can be finalised.
- 2. Annual tuition fee of € 4500 per student:** See payment conditions below.



Additional costs

The Harbour International School has no other additional fees, except for the camping trip in groups 6 and 7. The school fees cover all tuition costs, MR fees and lunchtime supervision costs. Costs for speech therapy and other specialists are the responsibility of the parents. The school plays no financial role in this.

Annual tuition fees

The Harbour International School is a partially-subsidised Dutch International School and therefore receives subsidies from the Dutch government. The subsidies received from the Dutch government cover only a part of the costs needed to run the school. This is the reason our school charges school fees.

The fees ensure quality international education by providing, for instance, small group size, second language teaching and special needs support as specified in the School Brochure 2026-2027, but also provide for translations, purchasing international learning aids, etc.

Our policy does not include sibling discounts.

The application fee must be paid for each child before admission can be finalised. By placing your child with the Harbour International School, you automatically accept responsibility for payment of the annual tuition fee.

For the annual school fee, a standard invoice will be sent to the parents/guardians. It is their responsibility to make sure all payments are made on time. **School fees are non-negotiable.**

Option 1: Payment of the total amount of €4500 before 21st September 2026

Option 2: Payment of €2250 before 21st September 2026 and €2250 before 17th December 2026

Option 3: Payment of €1500 before 21st September 2026, €1500 before 17th December 2026 and €1500 before 31st March 2027

Fees being paid by the parents' company can only be paid in one instalment.



Partial attendance during the school year 2026-2027

Before a student is withdrawn from school, a **minimum of 30 days' notice** must be given in **writing**. Failure to do so will result in fees continuing to be charged and any refund will be calculated from the month after the written notification.

Any non-standard situations will be assessed on a case-by-case basis, with fees adjusted as appropriate.

A separate fee structure applies to students entering group 0.
